It is more important than ever for college students to be aware of the constantly changing policies and procedures for a successful transfer to a four-year college or university. Students need to take an active role in their transfer by meeting with a Shasta College counselor on a regular basis (at least twice per semester) throughout their stay at Shasta College in order to review the transfer process and to create an educational plan. Students should also take it upon themselves to visit their future school of transfer in order to ensure that they making an informed decision on their future school of choice. Making a
