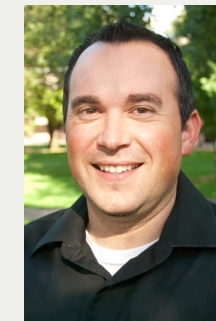

Message from the Transfer Center Director



What is an impacted major or program? Impaction is when more college applications are received from eligible students than can be accommodated by the campus or major. Impacted majors may often require a supplemental application in addition to the college admissions application. Impacted campuses and majors may also impose higher GPA requirements in order for the student to be eligible for admission. If you are applying to an impacted school or impacted major consider a second choice campus or alternate major that is not impacted. Make an appointment to see a Shasta College Counselor to find out which schools and majors are impacted.

Campus Highlight

CSU, Chico Online and in Redding

Students can earn their CSU, Chico degree right in Redding. Bachelor degree completion programs are offered at Shasta College's downtown University Center in Business Administration and online in Social Science, Sociology and Liberal Studies. A Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) for Registered Nurses (RN's) is also available, along with a Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) and Master of Social Work (MSW).

After completing Shasta College preparation, students can take CSU courses in Redding either part-time or full-time, completing their upper division coursework in two years. Apply to the University in Oct/Nov for the following fall, or begin your studies at the next term through Open University.

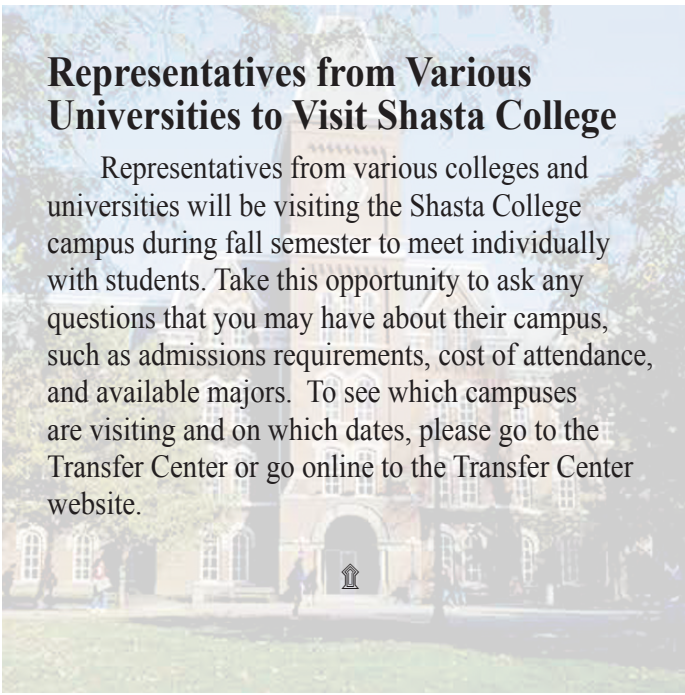

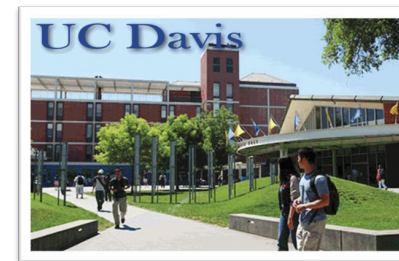
